

Anna Ratka, Ph.D., Pharm.D., RPh, CPE is Professor and Associate Dean of Academic Affairs at St. John Fisher College Wegmans School of Pharmacy. Dr. Ratka earned M.S. in pharmacy and Ph.D. in pharmacology from Poznan University of Medical Sciences (Poland) and Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) from Idaho State University (USA). She completed two post-doctoral fellowships, at University of Utrecht (Netherlands) and at University of Florida (USA). Dr. Ratka held several positions in academic pharmacy as a faculty member and as founding department chair, founding director of clinical research, and associate dean of academic affairs. She graduated from the American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy Academic Leadership Fellows Program. Dr. Ratka has taught pharmacology, pharmacokinetics, compounding, and pain. She is a Certified Pain Educator. Her research in neuropharmacology, neuroscience, opioids, pain, aging, and scholarship of teaching and learning resulted in over 100 publications and presentations. She is actively involved in service to American Association of Colleges of Pharmacy and American Pharmacists Association. As pharmacist, she practiced in community and hospital settings, and volunteers in healthcare projects to underserved communities.
